

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE CITY OF YAKIMA AND THE
YAKIMA POLICE PATROLMAN'S ASSOCIATION

1. The parties to this Memorandum of Understanding, the City of Yakima and the Yakima Police Patrolman's Association, enter this agreement to establish premium pay for the anti-crime unit members.
2. The parties' Collective Bargaining Agreement Article 23 shall contain a new section as follows:


Section 10 – Anti-Crime Unit Pay. Effective January 1, 2008, all patrol or special operations officers assigned to the Anti-Crime Unit shall be paid 1.75% of their current base pay in addition to their regular salary for each month assigned to the Unit.

3. In addition the Anti-Crime Unit will work a 21 day work schedule to reduce the effect of overtime for this purpose.
4. This agreement shall be effective upon signing and upon ratification by the Yakima City Council and the YPPA. The terms of this agreement shall be incorporated into the new collective bargaining agreement.




